



Anesthesia Recorder

The Anesthesia Recorder charts the anesthesia dosage given on each cat’s Medical Record and maintains the DKB Anesthesia Log.

Anesthesia Recorder Instructions

Buprenorphine and Ketamine® are Drug Enforcement Agency (DEA) controlled drugs and by law must be tracked from receipt to disposal. The DEA may inspect our records at any time. The Medical Director signs the completed DKB Anesthesia Log at the end of the clinic.

1. Complete the DKB Anesthesia Log:

- Record the dose, DKB bottle #, and time of each DKB injection in the DKB Anesthesia Log, and initial each entry. **Use a leading zero** in all dosages that are less than 1.0; for example, enter the amount as “0.25” cc, and not “.25” cc.
- Record any doses spilled or otherwise not injected into a cat.
- Submit the completed and signed DKB Anesthesia Log to the Clinic Supervisor at the conclusion of the clinic. The Clinic Supervisor will review it for compliance.

2. Complete the Medical Record:

- Enter the date of the clinic and the Cat ID# on the Medical Record, if it is not already pre-printed.
- Record and initial the dose and time of each DKB injection on the Medical Record. Use a leading zero in all dosages less than 1.0; for example, enter the amount as “0.25” cc, and not “.25” cc.
- Note vomiting or any other reaction to the anesthesia on the Medical Record.
- Insert the Medical Record into the plastic sleeve.
- Medical records must stay with the cat.

SURGICAL RECORD

Station Closing and Cleanup

When the clinic is concluded all station volunteers are expected to assist in the following:

- Inventory the remaining supplies and repack the supply kits. .
- Wipe and **dry** all plastic sleeves inside and out with disinfectant to clean.
- Clean all tables and the holding areas.
- Clear area of all trash and take the full garbage bags to the dumpster.
- **Complete the DKB drug log and return ALL drug vials, including empty vials, to the Clinic Supervisor. A completed drug log means it is signed by the Anesthetist and all blank areas are crossed off.**
