 04/03/2020 1 dose Quadriguard for dogs 25.1-50 lbs (136 mcg ivermectin chewable tablet) ← Prevents heartworms for 30 days. Treats roundworms, hookworms, tapeworms.

All dogs should stay on heartworm prevention at all times. Adopters can use any heartworm prevention, but it is a prescription so adopters must follow up with their vet.

Date surgery was completed. If surgery was completed within 10 days, follow post surgical instructions, which will be emailed to adopter. Important to keep surgery site dry and restrict activity. Surgery sites are closed with self-dissolving sutures, unless otherwise noted.

Induction:  
Midazolam 0.35-0.5mg/kg IV  
Ketamine 4-6mg/kg IV  
Meloxicam oral 1.5mg/mL 0.1mg/kg  
PO Once

Maintained on Isoflurane

The scrotal and surrounding hair was clipped. Chlorhexidine scrub was used to remove dirt and debris from the surgical area. Surgical prep was then completed with alternating Chlorhexidine scrub and solution.

An incision was made into the scrotum and through the median raphe. The first testicle was exteriorized with sharp dissection through the tunic, keeping the testicle closed. The cord was clamped and the testicle was cut away. The cord was ligated with a modified Miller's knot with appropriate sized Securodox suture and checked for hemorrhage. The above steps were repeated for the second testicle. A splash block of bupivacaine and splash of phenylephrine were applied to the scrotal incision. The incision was apposed with one simple interrupted suture in the subcutaneous tissue.

A small incision was placed through the prescrotal dermis and green ink was applied. The skin was pinched shut and surgical glue was applied to the skin of the tattoo.
